

What is all the hype about for ARIZONA GIVES on April 4th, 2023?

Seems like we just celebrated Giving Tuesday! Every other month there seems to be some kind of outreach for nonprofits to ask for financial support. The good news for procrastinators like me is that "Arizona Gives" happens a few weeks before "Tax Day" which is April 18th this year. "This early reminder gives me a boost to start preparing for that dreaded day when I get to pay more taxes. I am so thankful to support La Mesa Ministries because I can donate up to \$800 and receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit from the state of Arizona (single individuals can donate up to \$400). Better yet when I hear and see what my tax dollars are doing it bring me joy to know I am making a difference in the community. My tax dollars are preparing over 300 meals a week for the homeless and working poor. An eighty-one-yearold widow is getting assistance in finding an affordable home and getting transportation to medical appointments. A longtime resident on the streets finally received his social security benefits and had an \$1100 fine forgiven by the City of Mesa. Another long-time resident has been reunited with family. Eden Village our tiny house community for the Chronically homeless is making progress and close to purchasing a parcel of land. Three graduates of our financial management class are receiving 50% of their security deposit from La Mesa and moving into their new apartment this month. The list goes on and on and I hope you will join me by supporting La Mesa this "Arizona Gives" day. Your support does indeed change lives.
