It takes a lot to operate a nonprofit that provides resources to the community. It couldn't be done without the dedication of our volunteers. We have many who volunteer to make things happen at the Resource Center, but we have a special volunteer who remains behind the scenes and is constant no matter what. She enjoys being behind the scenes and she doesn't want any accolades, and we couldn't do what we do without her. Her name is **JOAN**, and she has been working behind the scenes almost as long as we have been open. She began by coming into the office and taking care of the filing once a week.
