Why Do We Need Narcan?



Recently, as the Mobil Loaves team loaded the truck, Jerry arrived unexpectedly. He wasn't going with them but wanted to drop off a few items they might need. Along with normal things, Jerry handed them packets of injectable Narcan, a drug that can reverse the deadly effects of an opioid overdose. The team had never experienced this and never thought about needing Narcan. Jerry sensed the team's confusion about why he brought it that day since they hadn't asked for it, and more importantly how to use it. "Don't worry" he said, "just give it to them and they'll know what to do." At the time they thought it was Jerry speaking to them, but they were wrong.

Along the route they stopped to prepare bags of food for people encamped nearby. As they pulled into the lot, they spotted some homeless people at a bus stop and Brian left on foot to give them bags as the others continued working. Suddenly he came running back, announcing that a man near the bus stop was experiencing a fentanyl overdose. "Grab the Narcan" he said. When they got to the man, he lay rolling helplessly on the ground, his eyes wide and confused. Jim called 911, as John and Brian awkwardly prepared the injection. They noticed crudely tattooed lines running from each corner of the man's lips up to his ears as if to say, "listen to me", and got the feeling that nobody ever had. As they finally drew up the life-saving liquid, Jim volunteered to inject the Narcan through the man's dirty hoodie and into his shoulder. The sound of sirens suddenly screamed for all of them.

In seconds the man stood but, hearing the sirens, he ran in fear, stumbling away from the gift they were trying to give him. He wasn't ready. Still groggy, the man collapsed again not far away, and the medics were able to reach him. As they took him away, the team knew they would never know the man's outcome, but they did know they had been blessed that day. Blessed with the gift of hope.

As they continued, they thought of the earlier conversation with Jerry and realized that when he said "Don't worry, just give it to them and they'll know what to do" it wasn't Jerry speaking to them, it was God speaking to Jerry.
